**The Evolution of a Biotech Start-up  
without Venture Capital Funding**

**Ray Johnson** helped found Cytonics in 2006 and is currently the President. He served as chairman on the Town of Jupiter's Economic Development Advisory Board, where he helped administer a \$3M venture investment fund to support biotechnology business development in Northern Palm Beach County.

**Cytonics Corporation** is a Biotech Research and Development company that develops diagnostics and treatments for orthopedic related pain. The company was founded in 2006 and established a research lab in 2008 at the Alexandria Innovation Center in Jupiter, FL. Cytonics has been able to commercialize numerous developments by finding the shortest possible path through the regulatory approval process. The company's early product commercialization has allowed Cytonics to raise over \$14M in funding from sources including public grants and private investment, without funding from institutional investors.
